Who are We?




- Nation's largest community development organization

- In Indianapolis since 1992
- LISC invested \$22.3 Million in Indy neighborhoods in 2017
- Promotes affordable housing and commercial development through grants, loans, and leveraged private capital
- Launched Centers for Working Families in 2008
- Supports “Quality of Life” neighborhood planning and “Great Places”
- Vibrant partnerships with EmployIndy, Indy Chamber, City, CBOs

Identify, develop, and implement strategies to enhance talent development in CBOs funded by LISC and EmployIndy.







